WHAT WE DO

More than a premier holiday event, Festival of Trees is the annual fundraiser for Quad City Arts, a local nonprofit arts organization dedicated to enriching the quality of life in the Quad Cities region through performing, visual and community arts programs and events. Quad City Arts also serves a dual role as an arts advocacy agency, re-granting an average of \$100,000 each year to individual artists, schools and non-profits in support of both community arts projects as well as capacity-building grants that support the arts. Over the past 35 years, Festival has evolved from a 2-day event in one room, into a 11-day event utilizing the entire 70,000 square foot River Center complex in Downtown Davenport.

The event features over 150 designer displays, 7 special events, the largest helium balloon parade in the Midwest, 3,000 volunteers and reaches over 100,000 people each year. Festival has a \$2.5 million dollar economic impact on the community and is recognized as one of the top events of its kind in North America, raising over \$7 million dollars in support of local arts since 1986.

Area senior living and nursing homes are invited to attend free of charge and buses are chartered in just for the occasion. complimentary refreshments, cookies and CenterStage entertainment offered to all guests during this private event. FAMILY DAY

(\$3,000) - SOLD OUT

A perfect outing for the entire family to enjoy...all the magic and attractions of Festival, at a reduced price of \$1 off general admission. Other fun features include fun photo opportunities, costumed characters, and special raffle items and giveaways.

MILITARY DAY

(\$2,500)

A proud salute to our soldiers in uniform, featuring discounted general admission tickets for military members (with military ID) and their immediate families. A color guard will present colors at 12:30 p.m. and the Star Spangled Banner will be played. Flags will adorn the atrium and entrance, and literature on benefits and resources for our military will be available.

FESTIVAL EXPRESS TRAIN

HIGH SCHOOL ART EXHIBIT

(\$3,000)

Over 150 area high school students from over 13 different schools display their art on the floor of Festival. A huge variety of mediums are featured in this attraction and recognition is given to award winners in various categories including "best in show". You won't want to miss this display!



TREE OF LIGHTS

(\$3,000)

Comprised of thousands of twinkly LED lights, synced to popular holiday songs! Watch in awe and wonder, as the light show comes all a glow at different times during Festival. This tree is over 3 stories tall and is a focal attraction of Festival placed directly in the Center of the designer trees.

SMALL WONDERS

(\$3,000) - SOLD

Adorable mini-trees, decorated sleighs, dioramas, and other unique holiday specialty crea-tions reside in this section. Some of these unique mini-creations are available for immediate purchase. Others can be won via the raffle that takes place throughout Festival.

TOY TREE

(\$3,000)

Want to be part of something really big?! Each year, new and unwrapped toys of all kinds adorn this 20-foot tree, making into a magnificent work of art for all to enjoy. At the end of Festival, all toys are donated to the local Toys for Tots so that hundreds more children in our community may enjoy a special holiday!

HONOR TREES

(\$2,500)

A beloved tradition, commem-orative honor and patriotic ornaments are available for purchase. Ornaments are per-sonalized and then displayed on special Honor Trees at Festival and then mailed to their home to enjoy as a keepsake.

BOOK TREE

(\$2,000) - SOLD

Like the ever popular "Toy Tree," this nearly 20-foot-tall tree will be decorated entirely with books donated from generous contributors in the community. After Festival, the books will be donated to local social service agencies for children in our community.

CENTERSTAGE

(\$10,000) - SOLD

A main attraction at Festival, Centerstage showcases over 3,000 entertainers with a wide variety of local talent during gen-eral admission hours. Dancers, singers, bands, and choirs fill the Great Hall with wonderful holiday entertainment to add to the magic and cheer.

VOLUNTEER CENTER

(\$2,500) - SOLD

Volunteer Center is the hub for 2,000 community volunteers, many of whom are our finest 'seasoned citizens'. They start their shift, take breaks, visit, and end their shift in this ac-tive space with snacks and beverages.

DESIGNER DOORS

(\$2,500)

Over 40 fabulous designer wreaths are created by the community and placed on red, green or white freshly painted designer doors in this popular designer display viewed by thousands of visitors. All wreaths are auctioned through bidding process over 10-day event.

BO THE BEAR

(\$2,000)

This amazing talking bear is the ambassador to Festival of Trees, welcoming visitors at the entrance to the Great Hall. Bo the Bear will give you direc-tions, tell stories or maybe even recite a poem or pass along a holiday joke.
